

Notice on the processing of personal data through a video surveillance (CCTV) system

1. Data Controller

A video surveillance (CCTV) system operates at the following premises:

- a) **1st klm Athinwn Ave , Kalyvia, 19010, Greece** and
 - b) **16th klm Marathon Avenue, Pallini, 15351, Greece**.

2. Purpose of processing and legal basis

We use a video surveillance system for the purpose of **protecting persons and property, preventing and investigating unlawful acts** (indicatively theft/damage), and **ensuring the security of our premises**. The processing is necessary for the purposes of **our legitimate interests** as the data controller (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR).

3. Legitimate interests assessment – necessity and proportionality

Our legitimate interest consists in the need to protect our premises, equipment, goods and property, as well as the life, physical integrity and safety of our staff and third parties who are lawfully present on our premises.

We collect **image data only** and limit recording to areas where we have assessed an increased likelihood of unlawful acts and/or increased security needs, specifically: **production areas, outdoor areas, showroom/exhibition area, offices**. No recording takes place in areas where private life could be disproportionately affected (e.g. restrooms, changing rooms, break/rest areas).

The system **does not record audio**.

4. Recipients – access to the footage

The recorded material is accessible **only** to authorised technical personnel of the company responsible for the operation/support of the system and the security of the premises.

There is no cooperation with an external CCTV company and the material is **not disclosed to third parties**, except in the following cases:

- a) to the competent judicial, prosecutorial and police authorities where it contains information necessary for the investigation of a criminal offence concerning persons or property of the company,
- b) to the competent judicial, prosecutorial and police authorities where data are lawfully requested in the performance of their duties, and
- c) to the victim or the alleged perpetrator of a criminal offence, where the data may constitute evidence of the offence, to the extent permitted by law.

5. Retention period

We retain the data for **fifteen (15) days**, after which they are **automatically deleted**.

If an incident is identified within the above period, we isolate the relevant excerpt and retain it for as long as required to investigate the incident and initiate/support legal proceedings, and in any case **no longer than strictly necessary**.

6. Data subject rights

Data subjects have the following rights:

- **Right of access:** you have the right to know whether your image is processed and, if so, to receive a copy.
- **Right to restriction:** you have the right to request restriction of processing, e.g. that data you consider necessary for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims are not deleted.
- **Right to object:** you have the right to object to the processing.
- **Right to erasure:** you have the right to request the deletion of your data, provided the legal conditions are met.

You may exercise your rights by sending an e-mail to **info@remi-sa.com**, by sending a letter to our postal address, or by submitting your request in person at our premises.

To examine a request relating to your image, you will need to indicate **approximately when** you were within the range of the cameras and provide information that facilitates your identification,

so that we can locate your data and protect (e.g. by masking/blurring) the data of other persons appearing in the footage. Alternatively, you may visit our premises so that we can show you the footage in which you appear.

Please note that exercising the right to object or erasure **does not necessarily result in** immediate deletion or modification of processing where lawful grounds for retention exist (e.g. incident investigation/legal claims). In all cases, we will respond within the time limits set by the GDPR.

7. Right to lodge a complaint

If you believe that the processing of your personal data infringes Regulation (EU) 2016/679, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.
